Notice to the candidates for Knowledge Test (KT)/Written Examination for the post of Male Constable (General Duty), against Advt. No. 8/2015, Cat. No. 1, Police Department, Haryana, in compliance of the order's of Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court.

2. Knowledge Test (KT):**60 Marks**

i. All those candidates who qualify the Physical Screening Test shall be given a Knowledge Test (KT) of 60 marks comprising of objective type multiple choice questions with the provision of **negative marking**.

ii. The knowledge test (KT) shall be of objective type having 100 multiple choice questions of 0.60 marks each and of 90 minute duration. The medium of examination shall be of Hindi except where the knowledge of English language of the candidate is to be tested. For each incorrect answer 0.15 marks shall be deducted.

iii. The test paper shall include questions on General studies, Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Reasoning, Current affairs, Numerical ability, General Science, Aptitude, relevant field/trade etc. The standard of questions shall be as expected of an educated person having passed 10+2 examination of Board of School Education, Haryana.

3. Interview-cum-Personality Test (I-PT)**10 marks**

Admit Card for Knowledge Test/Written Examination of the candidates will be uploaded on the Commission's Web-site i.e. www.hssc.gov.in. The candidates can download their admit cards for knowledge test (written test) from their respective login ID from the web-site of HSSC i.e. (www.hssc.gov.in) from **05.06.2017-onwards**. Candidates are advised to read the instructions on the Admit Card very carefully and follow the same strictly.

No separate call letters will be sent to the candidates by the Commission through post.

NOTE: -I

It is clarified that in view of the orders dated 08.05.2017 passed by the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court in LPA No. 1590 of 2016 (O&M), Vivek Singh & Ors, and other clubbed/covered matters, the above-stated concession is limited only in respect of the candidates who have approached Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court till the date of decision i.e 08.05.2017. The list of such candidates is available on Commission's Web-site i.e. www.hssc.gov.in. If name of any petitioner or appellants is not found mentioned in the list then he can approach the commission alongwith a copy of writ petition/LPA filed by him for obtaining his Roll No. for appearing in Knowledge Test/Written Examination. If a candidate/petitioner/appellant does not come forward and fails to appear in the above examination then the Commission shall not be responsible for the same.
